When is the trip?

Thursday, October 4, 2018

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| 9:00a.m. | Students depart school via charter bus |
| 9:30a.m. | Buses pick up adult guests (location TBD) |
| 11:30a.m. | Arrive at Mahalia Jackson for theatre experience |
| 12:00p.m. | Eat lunch at Louis Armstrong Park (weather permitting) |
| 12:30p.m. | Board buses for the Saenger Theatre |
| 1:00p.m. | Arrive at the Saenger Theatre |
| 2:00p.m. | Curtains rise for <i>Aladdin</i> at the Saenger |
| 5:00p.m. | Board buses following the performance |
| 7:00p.m. | Buses arrive back at RPE or alternate location |

*Times are approximate and subject to change as we get closer to the actual date.

Who may attend?

The trip is open to all 2nd grade students. Participation may be denied based on behavior concerns, as provided for in the Rollins Place Handbook. All supply fees and lunch money must be paid prior to this field trip.

Each student may also purchase one ticket for an adult chaperone to accompany him/her. Tickets will be sold in the order in which full payments are received. No siblings are allowed to attend.

All attendees MUST ride the charter buses and follow our schedule.

What is the cost?

The price is **\$120.00** per student and **\$130.00** for an adult chaperone.

Price includes:

- charter bus transportation to and from New Orleans
- a snack for the bus ride home
- one ticket to the touring Broadway production of *Aladdin*

Make checks payable to "RPE".

We will accept one half payment (\$60) to reserve a student ticket and one full payment (\$130) to reserve a chaperone ticket by August 2 (RPE Open House). After August 2, only full student/chaperone payments will be accepted thru Tuesday, September 4.

A chaperone ticket may be purchased at the same time as student tickets.

How will we handle meals?

Students will eat breakfast at school prior to departing for the field trip. Students will bring a lunch from home or a bag lunch from the cafeteria. Chaperones attending will need to bring a lunch from home.

Who will watch my child if I do not attend?

Each bus will include several RPES teachers and many parent chaperones. Students without a guardian present will be assigned to a teacher for the entire trip.

What should I wear?

People usually dress in their Sunday best, so something dressy (but comfortable for the bus ride) would be best! More details regarding dress will be sent home prior to the trip. Students attending the field trip are allowed to wear their theatre outfit to school that day in place of a uniform.

How is this educational?

Students will have considerable preparation on viewing and responding to drama experiences through our participation in the LAA+ Network. All teachers at RPE, including ancillary and classroom teachers, will work together to enrich this experience through classroom activities and lessons.
