What is the Caldecott Medal?

The Caldecott Medal is given annually to the "most distinguished American picture book for children." The winner of the Caldecott Medal is given a gold seal, while the Caldecott Honor Books are given a silver seal. Where can I get books?

The RPE Library has a copy of all the most recent Caldecott books. Students are welcome to check them out. The RPE Library is open every morning from 8:40-9:00. Students are sent to the library to exchange books based on teacher discretion.

Every branch of the EBR Public Library also has a copy of each Caldecott winner and honor books. The EBR library has asked that you only check out 1-2 winners at a time to give everyone in the community an opportunity to access the books.
